- If your child did not attend Sabot at Stony Point in the 2016/17 school year, you will be asked to complete other paperwork required by Virginia State Licensing. We will provide guidance and the forms.
- To be eligible for *A Sabot Summer*, children must be 3 years of age and toilet trained by June 1, 2017. Three-year-olds who did not attend Sabot in the 2016/17 school year may be invited for an introductory visit.
